At a legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sidney Qualified to Vote in the choice of Senators assembled in said town on Monday the Second day of September AD 1816, for the purpos of choosing one or more Delegates to represent them in a Convention to be convened at Brunswick meeting house near the College in the District of Maine on the last Monday of September, AD 1816. ---

Votes for the following persons were given in sorted counted and recorded, and delaration therof made as is by law directed as set against their names (viz)

For Ambrose Howard Esq^r Ninety eight votes ---98
 Amos Partridge Esq^r Sixty seven votes ----- 67
 Moses Hastings one vote -----1
 Daniel Tiffany six votes-----6
