Dear Mrs. Hustus:

The Provost Marshal General has directed me to supplement the information you received recently concerning the above-named prisoner of war.

Information has been received which indicates that he is interned in the transit camp indicated above. Since he is interned in a transit camp, it is impossible to direct letters and parcels to him at this time. When his permanent internment address is received, one parcel label, two tobacco labels, and mailing instructions will be forwarded without application on your part.
