Description: Announcement of Hallowell, Augusta & Bangor mail stage

HALLOWELL, AUGUSTA & BANGOR [Illustration] MAIL STAGE.

The Hallowell, Augusta and Bangor Mail Stage will leave Hallowell every Thursday at 3 o'clock, A.M. Passes through Augusta; Vassalborough, China, Albion, Unity, Joy, Dixmont, Newburg, Hamp' den, and arrives at Bangor same day at 6 o'clock, P.M.—Leave Augusta every Sunday and Tuesday at 3 o'clock, A. M. and arrive at Bangor same days at 6 o;clock, P. M.

Returning, leave Bangor for Augusta every Monday and Friday at 3 o'clock, A.M. and arrive at Augusta same days at 6 o'clock, P. M.—Leave Bangor for Augusta and Hallowell every Wednesday at 3'clock, A.M. and arrive at Hallowell same day at 6 o'clock, P.M.

Stage Books kept at CHICK'S Maine Coffee House, Bangor, at HAMLEN'S Kennebec & Stage Tavern, Augusta, and at DILLING-HAM'S Washington Hotel, Hallowell.

The Proprietors of the above line, inform the public, that they will not be acountable for any Baggage, unless the fare is paid and the same entered on the Way Bill.
