

New York Sept 17th 1846

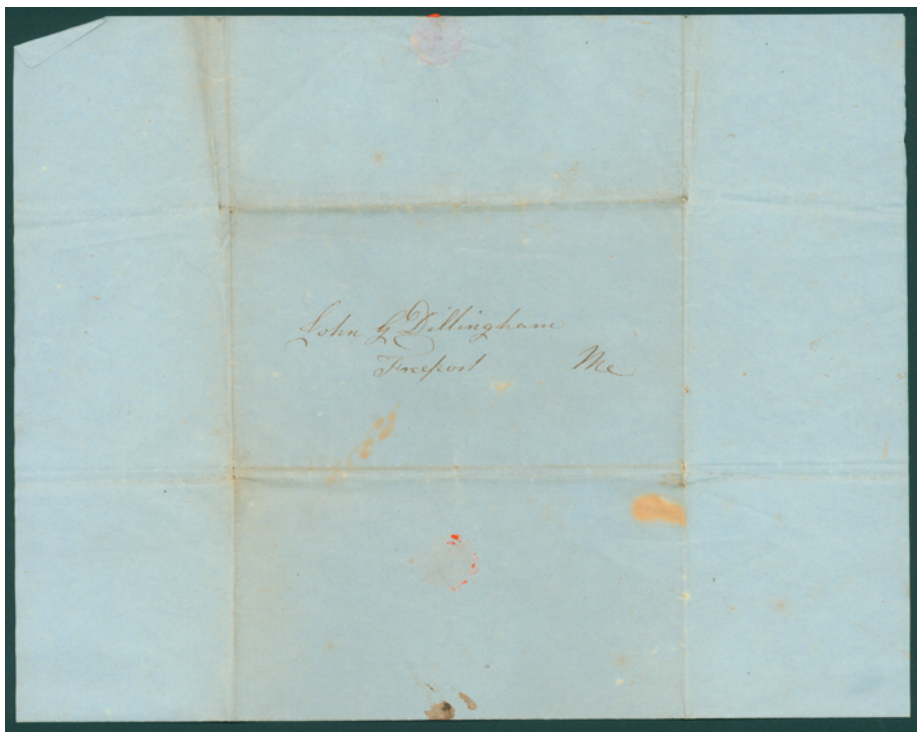
Dear Wife
