## Portland May 27th 1825

My Dear Wife

The bearer of this line is M<sup>r</sup> Packard one of the Professors in Boudowin College, the Gentlemen in Company with him are the Cellebrated Doctor Welles and M<sup>r</sup> Stowe & M<sup>r</sup> Smill two of the tutors in said College, all Gentlemen of high respectability, I am very sorry that I could not be at home to wait on them, I wish they may be treated with the respect and attention, that is so Justly due to their Caracters – – Your affectionate Husband
