VOLUNTEER ENLISTMENT.

STATE OF [eagle] TOWN OF
 Maine Portland

I, Grenville F. Sparrow a resident of Portland born in Portland in the State of Maine aged Twenty-five years, and by occupation a clerk DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have volunteered this Twenty-second day of July ~ 1862, to serve as a SOLDIER in the ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, for the period of THREE YEARS, unless sooner discharged by proper authority: Do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as are, or may be, established by law for volunteers. And I, Grenville F. Sparrow do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.

I CERTIFY, ON, HONOR, That I have minutely inspected the Volunteer, Grenville F.
