Dear Sir:

We sent you by steamer today 1 Bale
202 lbs. 24th soft twine.
Please have same all knit into Laundry Nets
28 inches long x 56 inches around 1 1/4 in. mesh.
We do not want the mesh any smaller than 1 1/4 inch.
The laundry nets that you have made for us recently of
1 1/4 in. mesh the size is little smaller than we want it.
We do not want the mesh very much larger than what
you have been making for 1 1/4 inch - but just a little.

Your postal card received - the weight we gave
208 lbs. is the weight given us - possibly the twine
has been in stock some time and shrunk a little
in weight.
