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

which sum added to that already paid as above stated will amount to \$7375.74 which will be less by \$124.26 than the estimated cost of the land & building according to the report & plan heretofor presented to the town, and adopted. As some of the tenements in the building are ready for rent and others will be so very soon, the Committee recommends that some persons or town officer be appointed to take charge of the building with authority to lease such parts thereof as are intended for that purpose and to collect & pay into the Treasury the rents therefor.


