

Portland Monday Eve.

I have just returned from Saccarappa where I have been talking with the Directors of the Maine Manufacturing CoThey want us to set a price on all our water power & mills on the lower falls, & on the house & lumber yard – The Mills &c are occupied by us for ten years unless the Co wants them – in which case they will give us one hundred dolls. per year for the unexpired time.

They want our price, & terms of payment in writing tomorrow at 10 o clock, and also the quantity of stock we will take – You will judge wether this is worth your coming into town to see about it –
