Sir - Yours bearing date Dec 5th 1834, has come to hand & is now under consideration, in relation to the appointment of a Reporter for the State of Maine in case that office should be vacated by Mr Fairfield, I can say that I should be highly gratified to see you promoted to that office, I know of no one that is making any Interest for that office altho it may be thought by some that Cumberland, is securing to large a share of public patronage through the executive appointments, but I for one under present circumstances, so far as I can render you any assistance, full to perform it with chearfulnes and have inclosed a Letter to your charge to the Govennor agreeable to your request. please write me on the receipt of this.
