Greeting.

Know Ye, that at a District Court of the United States, begun and holden at Portland, within and for the Maine District, on the nineteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six To wit: on the nineteenth day of August A. D. 1856

Patrick Kerr

of Portland in said District,  
born at County Donegal, Ireland,  
having produced the evidence, and taken and subscribed the oath, required by law, was admitted to become a citizen of the said United States, according to the Acts of Congress, in such case made and provided.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed the Seal of said Court, at Portland afore= said, this nineteenth day of August A.D. 1856, and in the eighty first year of the Independence of the United States of America.
