NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS.

By an Ordinance of the City Tax Bills are to be issued, and if paid within 60 days 5 *per cent discount* will be allowed. Interest will be charged after the expiration of the discount. If not paid within four months, a *summons* to be issued. If not paid ten days after such *summons*, with twenty cents for said *summons* a *warrant* to be issued causing additional costs.

All taxes assessed on Real Estate, become a lien on said estate. The certificate of abatement must be exhibited to the Collector, and all costs and fees incurred before such an exhibition must be paid. *Each partner* is liable for the *whole* tax assessed to his firm.
