Sirs:-In pursuant to a vote passed at a legal meeting called for the purpose of protecting Clams in the Town of Scarborough January 6, 1853, we the Selectmen of the Town of Scarborough hereby permit you the said John Kilbourn and Son Augustus Scott Kilbourn, all of the town of Scarborough to dig any quantity of Clam bait you please from the twentieth day of February, to the twentieth day of May 1853, provided that you do not injure any of the thatch beds
