 during the war is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States
 this Seventeenth day of June, 1865, at Portsmouth
Virginia by reason of the War Dept dated May 3 1865
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist*.)

 in the State of _____, is 25 years of age,
5 feet 7 1/2 inches high, Dark complexion, Dark eyes,
Dark hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Weaver
