If I received another before writing I like to have forgoton to tell you that I am alive my health is good a usual I am glad to hear that you are all well I have had to write to a number of late that you know nothing about but prehaps you will some time dont like to trouble you about it at presant I dont know what grate danger you think I am in here, I know of none except that I may be hisked by Mewls I am now watch over three stables there is one hundred and fifty Mewls in each stable and six Horses the man got drunk that was on watch in the stables and I took his place they will probly keep me here untill I get drunk and that wont be untill we get a paid off again Feb 18, I will finish this morning my date yesterday should have been the 17, my ink has been frozen and writes bad tell Seldon Florence and Elmer they mist learn as fast as they can tell Little Lincoln to be a good Boy Diana I should like to write more but have not time my respects to all write soon from your Husband Marshall S.
