Description: J.M. and C.R. Knapp wrote to Col. George F. Shepley of the 12th Maine Regiment seeking pay for recruiting sailors for him.

Portland Dec. 20th 1861 Col Shepley

Gent. when you was in our office you proposed for us to get some sailors for your Battery and we went to work and made a business of it and got 25 or 30 men, and Capt Thompson has left and not payed us one cent, now we dont think it more then right for us to have our pay say two dollars per head as you promised, the was other officers that offered us three dollars per head and cash down when they enlisted, but we done all for you that we could we gave the list of names that we sent to your office enlist, he will show it to you in Lowell. Mr Jose said he would speak to you about it but he may forget it so we thought we would drop a few lines
