difficulties recruiting men in the Orono area.

Orono Dec 20th 1861 Col Shpley Sir

It is almost useless to open an office to obtain recruits in this part of the State The only manner that recruits can be raised speedily is by driving about the Country I am informed that no bills will be paid except the Subsistance bills transportation of troops & eight dollars per month for office rent no provision is made for Horse hire Stage fare &c for a Recruiting Officer I shall govern myself by the above information untill I receive orders from you
