We, the undersigned being a committee appointed by the Vice President to hear a complaint brought by the President, Mr. Abrahamson, against a brother director, Abraham Rodman, at a hearing held last night at the office of the Chairman of the committee, Mr. Greenstein, wish to report that a full hearing was held on the above-mentioned charge before the entire committee in the presence of the complainant, defendant, and witnesses, respectively submit the finding as follows:

The committee unanimously finds the defendant was guilty of conduct unbecoming a director and member of the above-mentioned Congregation. Now therefore it is the recommendation of the committee that the defendant make a public apology to the President during Sabbath services on either June 15 or June 22, and also be suspended as director for a period of three (3) months to take effect immediately.

The committee further recommends that in the event the defendant does not make this apology within the time stated above, he shall be suspended as both director and member until such time as he shall comply with the sentence of this committee. Respectfully submitted:
