That I, Rabbi David Essrig, of Portland, County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to me, this day paid by Congregation Shari Tefilah, a religious corporation duly organized and existing by law, and having a Synagogue on Newbury Street in Portland, said County and State, and in consideration of a certain contract this day entered into by and between me and the said Synagogue, and in further consideration of a certain Bill of Sale this day to me given by said Synagogue of all its right, title, and interest in and to certain furniture, and furnishings heretofore given to me, and now at my home at 91 India Street, said Portland, do hereby agree that all of said furniture and furnishings located in my home, as aforesaid, and so given to me by the Synagogue, shall stand subject to and as security for my faithful performance of the terms and conditions and obligations assumed by me in a certain contract with said Synagogue this day entered into; it being understood and agreed that if I commit a breach of said contract, then said furniture may be held by the officers of said corporation as security for any damage sustained by said Synagogue by reason of any breach of said contract by me, otherwise said furniture shall be free and clear of all claims and demands whatsoever.
