Auburn Oct, 8th 1863

Friend Watson,

Sir, I wish you to take the inclosed lettrs to the Surgeon Genral, and get a reply, and send it to me as soon as possible, My health until very lately has been very bad for two or three days at a time, unable to do anything, It is now quite good, I have a hundred dollars which I intend to expend for the benefit of sick & wounded soldiers i perhaps I may expend it for dried fruit, & send it on to Hayes, may come on myself — Give my respects to Mr Samson,

tell him I here of his good deeds,
