CHORUS,.....And he shall purify.  
RECIT, (Alto,).....Behold! a Virgin shall conceive.  
AIR (Alto) AND CHORUS,.....O thou that tellest good tidings.  
RECIT, (Bass,).....For behold darkness.  
AIR, (Bass,).....The people that walked in darkness.  
CHORUS,.....For unto us a child is born.  
PIANO SOLO,.....Pastoral Symphony.  
RECIT, (Soprano,).....There were shepherds.  
RECIT, (Soprano,).....And lo! the Angel of the Lord.  
RECIT, (Soprano,).....And the Angel said unto them.  
RECIT, (Soprano,).....And suddenly.  
CHORUS,.....Glory to God in the highest.  
AIR, (Soprano,).....Rejoice greatly.  
RECIT, (Soprano,).....Then shall the eyes of the blind.  
AIR, (Soprano,).....He shall feed his flock.  
CHORUS,.....His yoke is easy.

AIR, (Soprano,)..... But thou didst not leave.

RECIT, (Tenor,)..... Unto which of the Angels.  
CHORUS,..... Let all the Angels of God.  
CHORUS,..... The Lord gave the world.  
AIR, (Soprano,)..... How beautiful are the feet.
