Warrenton Junction Sep 15 1863

My Dear Father I have a few moments to spare so I will write you a few line. I am dismounted. and am at Warrentn Junction expecting to go up on the next train to Alexandria to the dismounted camp I was dreadful sorry to have to come to the rear just when a fight was to come off for I want to be in all the battles I tryed to go but the Capt could not let me for my horse had been condemned and

and was ordered to be laten to the rear our Regiment - was not engaged · so I heard. If we go to Olexandrice I have half a mind he get a chance in the War Department - as clerk I could do it - Easy and never need go to the regiment-again, I have notwhally made up my mind as to this but I think 1- would be a good chance for me, I like soldiering no some respects and others Ido mit I may possibly get a Sergeants- borth in a few months but - that is no inducement-for me to stay in the required - if I care get a much better chance I want you

and was ordered to be taken to the rear our regiment was not engaged so I heard. if we go to Alexandria I have half a mind to get a chance in the War Department as clerk I could do it easy and never need go to the regiment again. I have not wholly made up my mind as to this but I think it would be a good chance for me. I like soldiering in some respects and others I do not I may possibly get a Sergeants berth in a few months but that is no inducement for one to stay in the regiment if I can get a much better chance I want you
