Twenty mile androscoggin ^{So called} falls ^{about} twenty four years Past we Lived at little River just below the ten mile falls and at the upper [hole in paper] of the falls there was an old - Cellar in which there was oak tree of a considerable bigness which cellar was always said to be the place over which one Thomas Purchase house stood where he once lived which Place we have never have heard Disputed or contradicted by any body since we first heard of it or knew it which we are willing to attest to everything when Requested before a magistrate Dated at Burnt Meadows September 28 1787
