Greeting.

Having appointed you to be a Corporal of the E Volunteer Company of Light Infantry, commanded by me, in the First Regiment, \_\_\_\_\_ Brigade, First Division, of the Militia of Maine:

By virtue of the Power vested in me, I do, by these Presents, grant you this Warrant. You are, therefore, with vigilance and fidelity, to discharge the duty of Corporal, in said Company, according to the Military Rules and Regulations established by law, for the Government and Discipline of the Militia of this State. And you are to observe and follow such orders and instructions, as you shall, from time to time, receive from your superior officers.
