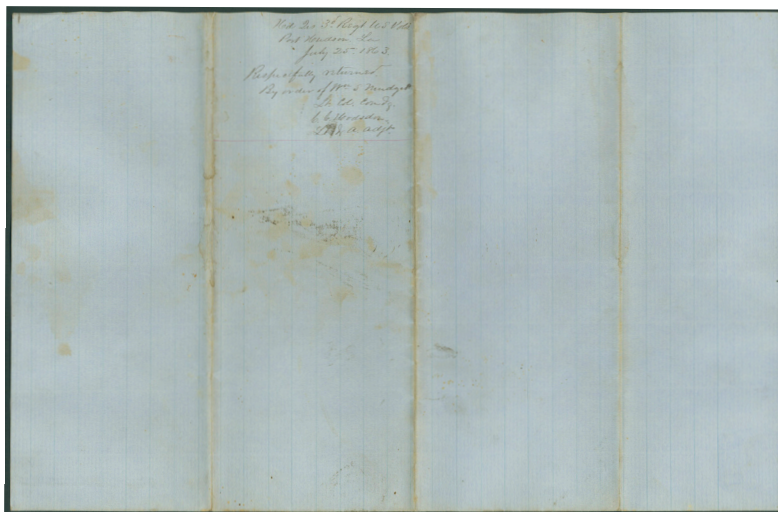

Port Hudson July 25th 1863

To Major General N. T. Banks commanding department of the Gulf
Sir

continued ill health and the rigor
of this climate compells me to send in my resignation.
i have served faithfully in the trenches dureing the
memorable Siege of Port Hudson. as my immediate
commanding Officers can attest. hence no motive can be
attributed to me but the above in taking this step
i herewith tender my resignation as (1st) first
Lieutenant of Co H (3^d) third Regt United States Volunteers
General Ullmans Brigade
