Sebago Dec 14 1868
The following are the votes taken by the

town of Sebago at different times to raise money for money for those men who volunteered, were drafted or furnished substitutes for the army.

At a legal meeting holden July 26. 1862 the following votes were taken-

Art. 2d "Voted and raise eleven hundred dollars to pay eleven volunteers who shall enlist into the service of the United States.

Art. 3d Voted and authorized the Selectmen to hire eleven hundred dollars to pay the eleven volunteers who shall enlist and the said sum shall be paid to them whenever mustered into the United States service"
