Sebago June 18th 1865

Dear Father I now sit down to write a few lines to let you know how the folks are Lizzie is gaining slowly she has been very sick Billy has been worse lately Uncle Seth & Mother carried him up to see Doctor Robins he says they are fits for two days he has been sick to his stomack & was quite feverish but he is better today & he has not had any of them spells yet Abram & Ellen are here now. & Uncle Sam has been out to day but has gone home we like our school firstrate our teachers name is Annette Smith From Steep falls. I had a letter from Mary yesterday She is going to School to Gorham yet She & her mother are both well. Joe has got half done hoeing if not more Hattie Day has give Bill the sack she is keeping company with Isaac [Gool?] he is a Brother to Isaac Lamberts wife I

guess she has not made out much for they say he is a real rogue they have been to portland last week to see Father Sweet. I guess I will not write any more now perhaps mother will want to write som so I will close by saying good by write often from Elsie
