[written in red ink] added & checked - Proof good  
1 James E. Tyler 9 mos Sept 29/62 K 25. 100" [in red] this man is credited to Gorham - Send proof that you paid him a bounty.  
[in red] added & checked - Proof good  
2 Eben Ward 9 mos. " " K 25. \$100." [In red] He is credited to Westbrook  
Did you pay bounty? Send proof.  
[in red] Sub added & checked - proof good  
3 Daniel Whitten 9 " put in sub for 9 mos 100. [in red] Records show that he did put in a sub.  
Edward Harmon of Co. E 25 - is credited to Westbrook - Send proofs & explanation
