 10, 1862.

Raymond, September 15, 1862  
 Personally appeared before me, Charles Weed of Sebago  
 And declared upon his honor, that he had not previously been examined and refused a Certificate of  
 Disability by any Physician or Surgeon appointed by the Governor and Commander-in-Chief to  
 Make examinations of drafted men; and I certify, on honor, that I have carefully examined said  
 Charles Weed and find him incapable of performing military duty, by  
 Reason of \* General debility  
 Which disability is, in my judgment + Permanent.
