CERTIFICATE OF DISABILITY ENTITLING TO EXEMPTION FROM MILITARY SERVICE UNDER DRAFT OF SEPTEMBER 10, 1862.

September 15, 1862 Raymond,

Personally appeared before me, Charles Weed of Sebago

And declared upon his honor, that he had not previously been examined and refused a Certificate of Disability by any Physician or Surgeon appointed by the Governor and Commander ~in~Chief to Make examinations of drafted men; and I certify, on honor, that I have carefully examined said Charles Weed and find him incapable of performing military duty, by

Reason of * General debility

Which disability is, in my judgment + Permanent.
