Sir,

The voucher of Lieut. Col. S. Eastman US. A. for 23.564 lbs of Straw delivered at Camp Butler for the 12<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Maine vols, upon your certificate, expended on the remark – "The number of troops, time in camp before mustering into service required – vide Army Reg¹ 1126"– Par– has been submitted to the Secretary of War, & returned with the following endorsement.
