The 12th Maine Regt there under my command was encamped at Camp Butler in the months of October and November. A part of

the time the grand was covered men were without overcoals and a Therever I can obtain acceps to adjutant General

the time the ground was covered with snow and most of the time the men were without overcoats and a portions of them without blankits

The Quartermaster who was then with the Regt has resigned and his papers are in Maine

Whenever I can obtain access to these documents I think I shall be able to show that the certificate conforms to the facts and that all was supplied to which I certified and no more than was abso= =lutely necessary under the circumstances.
