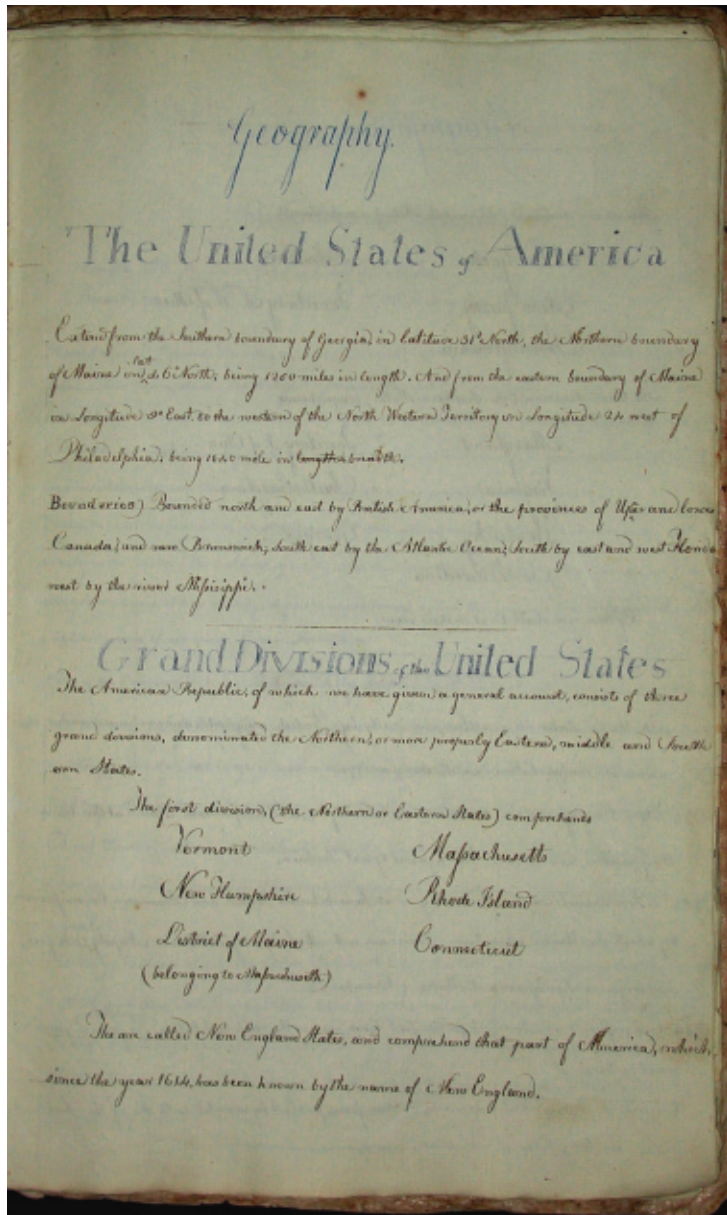

Geography.

The United States of America

Extend from the Southern boundary of Georgia, in latitude 31° North, the Northern boundary of Maine in 46° North; being 1250 miles in length. And from the eastern boundary of Maine in Longitude 8° East, to the western of the North Western Territory in Longitude 24 west of Philadelphia; being 1040 miles in length breadth.

Boundaries Bounded north and east by British America, or the provinces of Up^r and lower Canada and new Brunswick; south east by the Atlantic Ocean; South by east and west Florida west by the river Mississippi.

Grand Divisions of the United States

The American Republic of which we have given a general account, consists of three grand divisions, denominated the Northern, or more properly Eastern, middle and South States.

The first division, (the Northern or Eastern States) comprehends

Vermont	Massachusetts
New Hampshire	Rhode Island
District of Maine	Connecticut

(belonging to Massachusetts)

The area called New England States, and comprehend that part of America, which since the year 1614, has been known by the name of New England.
