



To Sylvanus Bacheldor one of the Constables of the Town of Baldwin you are hereby Required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to Summon and notify the freeholders and other inhabitants of Said Town Qualified by Law to Vote in town meetings viz as pay to one Single Tax besides the poll as polls a sum Equal to Two thirds of a Single poll tax to assemble at Richard Fitches house on monday the 6th Day of September 1802 at 12: o Clock to act on the following articles

1st to Choose a moderator for the good order of sd meeting.
 2d to see what sum or sums of money the Town will raise for the repair of roads the support of schools and other Town charges as the town may see fit -----
