Description: Fred N. Dow, the son of Neal Dow wrote to George F. Shepley asking him to send the senior Dow's baggage to Portland.

Portland Dec 9 1863 Gen Geo. F. Shepley Dear Sir: My Father (Gen. Neal Dow) writes me from Richmond telling me to request you, if perfectly convenient to yourself, to allow your servant to forward his baggage - now with Mr. Morse of the City Hotel New Orleans – There are several parcels I believe - Saddle Box, Mess Chest – Chest of Books &c. &c. I suppose these can come by Govt transport to N. Y. and thence by Steam Boat to Portland -

give you ben't - directions above it you view confee a great favor of Fatter and soize Jones Very Respectfully Thed N. Down.

give your serv't - directions about it you will confer a great favor of Father and oblige -
