


Roof good. Paint fair. Two front rooms metal cealing. 2 gas pumps.

A lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the easterly side of Main Street, so called, and described and bounded as follows: Commence on said side of said St., at the westerly corner of the laundry building and Frank T. McCann; thence run northwesterly and by said Street for a distance of 61 feet to a point which is 13 feet southeasterly (on the line of said Street) of the most easterly corner of said Street of the Meat Shop Lot of one Benj. W. Gibbs; thence northeasterly and parallel with and 13 feet therefrom, easterly line of said Meat-Shop lot of point in line with the back line of said Meat Shop Lot, thence northwesterly 13 feet to the easterly back corner of said Meat-Shop lot and continuing on the back line of said lot, to its westerly back corner, which is a stone poston the line of land known as the Hotel Lot, now believed to be owned by L. A. Wiggin, thence northeasterly and by line of said last named land to Stevens Brook, thence south-

easterly by and down said Brook to the westerly back corner of the aforesaid Laundry Building lot of said Frank T. McCann; thence southwesterly and by said McCann's said lot to said main street, and to point thereon begun at.

Also do I hereby convey to the Grantee hereof one-half in common and undivided a parcel of land lying in the above described premises and said Gibb's Meat Shop Lot, the same being 13 feet on said Street and extending back there from as far as said Meat Shop Lot, and the back or rear of portion the premises herein first above described.
