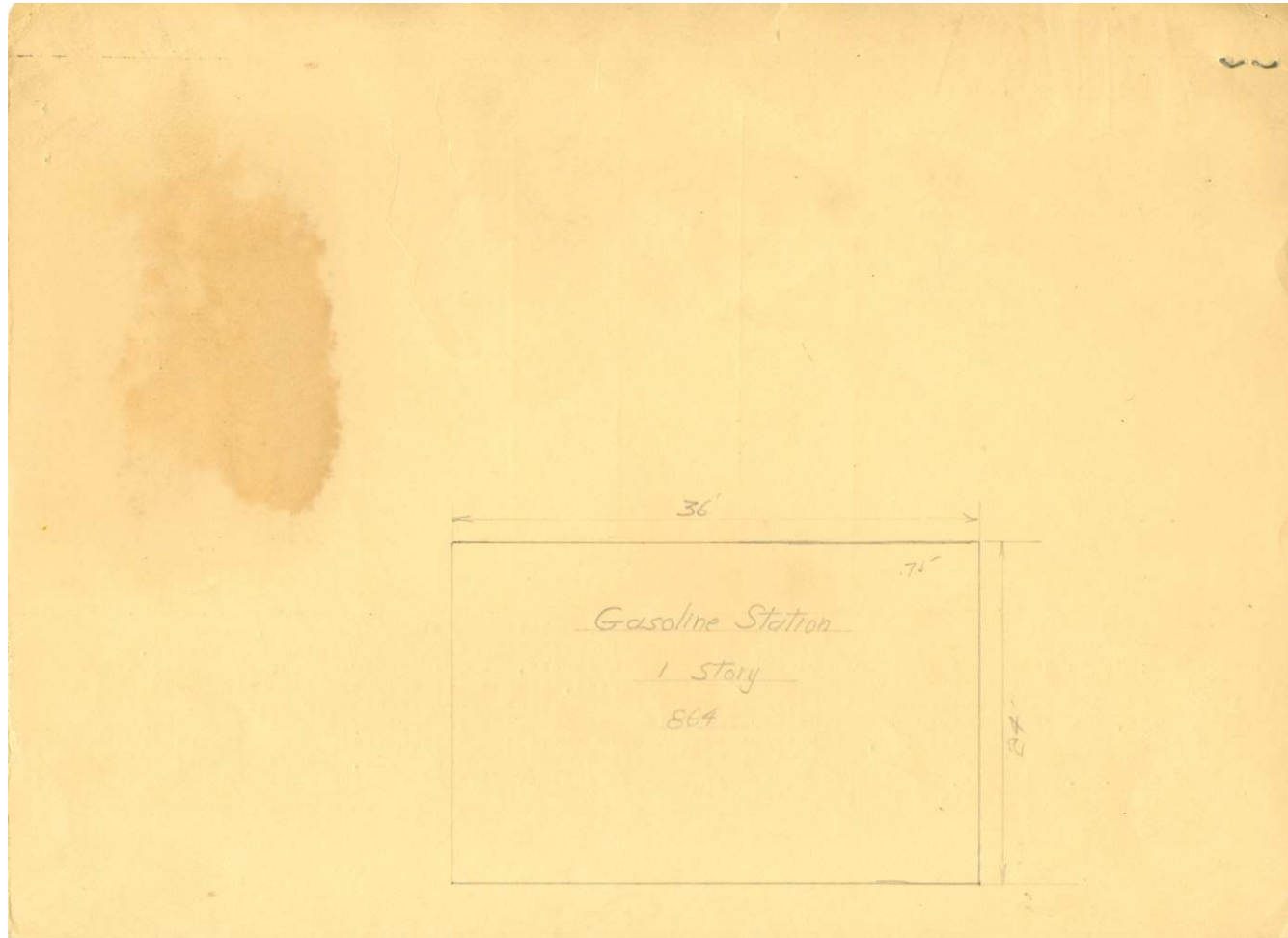


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#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

BOOK 1519 PAGE 140 May 19th, 1937.

A lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the South side of Main Street, so called; Commence on the southerly side of said Main Street, at the westerly face of a cement wall which runs nearly perpendicular to said Main Street, thence easterly by said Main Street about 61 feet and 1 inch to an iron pipe driven in the ground at or near the southerly side of said Main Street, thence southerly on a line parallel with one foot easterly from the foundation of the Filling Station Building; on the premises hereby conveyed and continuing in the same line southerly to an iron pipe driven in the ground at or nearest bank of Meadow Brook, thence up said Brook to land of H. G. Larrabee, and thence northerly by the westerly face of a stonewall and the face of the first mentioned cement wall to the point of beginning.
