A lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the North side of Main St., so called and bounded as follows:— Commenciar on said northerly side of Main St. at the southeasterly corner thereon of the Central Garage lot so called, now or formerly of Ripley Fletcher, formerly owned by Pridgton Savings Bank; thence running easterly by said Main St. (35) feet, more or less; thence north (39) degrees and (40') east (98) feet to an iron hub set in the ground; thence northwesterly and on a line parallel with said Main St. (35) ft. more or less, to the easterly line of said Garage lot; thence southerly and by the easterly side-line of said last named lot to its southeasterly corner on said street, being the north themselve heaven heaven heaven. the point thereon begun at.

Also one half part in common and undivided in and to the following described parcel of land, line next and easterly off the above described premises:- Commencing on said northerly side of Main St. and the southeasterly corner thereon of the above described premises;

thence running easterly by said Street (15) feet more or less; thence run northerly and parallel with the easterly state of said above described premises (98) feet, thence northwesterly to the northeasterly corner of the above premises and thence southerly by said easterly side line thereof to said Street and point begun at.
