


101 Main Street. Thomas R. Skelton; Part of lot (7) Range (13) bounded as follows:— Commence on the southerly dide of said Main Street, and at the northwesterly corner theron of land this day owned by Ada Maude Lakin and Harriett T. Barrett, known as the "Old Sharon Homestead", thence run Westerly by said Main Street (26) feet to an iron pipe driven into the ground; thence South (50) and (20)' West to an point on the northerly side-line of land of the town of Bridgtomm being the lot whereon stands a school building known as the "Center Hall" lot; thence easterly and by the last named lot to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence southerly and by the easterly end-line of said school building lot to the original "bank stone wall", on the line of the original "Union School District" lot; thence easterly and by said last named line to the southwesterly corner of the above named "Sharon Place" of Lakin and Barrett, aforesaid, and which said corner is on the northerly range line of said (13)th Range; thence northerly and by said Lakin & Barrett said land to its northwesterly corner of said Main Street, being the point and bound begun at.
