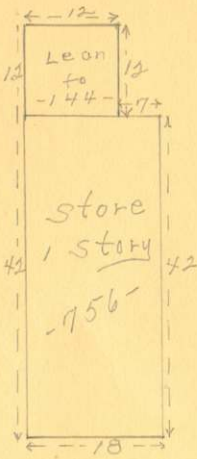
DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Store on Main St. Gertrude A. Nickerson; bounded as follows:-Commence on the northerly side of said Main St. at the point where the center line of the brook running through said "Walker Meadow" intersects the side line of said street, thence Westerly by said Main St. to an iron pipe driven 2 feet easterly of the southeasterly corner of the building of Eugene Chaplains now occupied by Melvielo B. Cook; thence northerly and parallel with the easterly side of said building to an iron pipe driven in the ground 2 feet easterly of the northeasterly corner of said building and thence continuing on northerly and on the same line of direction of said pipe so driven by said side of said building to land heretofore sold by George W. Newcomb to Fred C. Gibbs and Willie E. Crosby thence easterly by said Gibbs and Crosby land to the center of said brook thence southerly down the center of said Brook to Main St. and the point of Commencement.
