Tell the kind Nun's, & all your associates that I invoke for them, & myself, the aid of our holy Mother Mary, of all the holy Angels, of all the Saints, of our Father in heaven and our Blessed Saviour, & Redeemer, that they will intercede and interpose for & in our behalf, that we may all be guided, guarded, comforted and kept in all our ways, and finally be all graciously received, and hailed by our Lord as true sons & Daughters of the Almighty Maker of Heaven & Earth. I left the Family & Friends well, & will only add that I wish you to remain where you are untill myself or Mr. Stoneham call's or send for you I am with constant affection Your Father Ellis B. Usher
