## Portland April 21 1865

Mr Evans Dear Sir I hope you will pardon me for being so bold as to ask any thing more of you I want to find out all I can in regard to my brother I can get a letter from Secretary fessenden in this City but it will not insure me a pass now for it was impossiable for Mrs General Dix to pass through our lines this week and it will be impossiable for me to get through now but as soon as they allow anyone to pass through I can get a pass but I will ask you if you will go th to the Maine State agency at City Point and enquire for Mrs Rebecca Usher and tell her all the facts pertaining to where my

a girl by that name he will be likely to know my brother and perhaps would know something that would be of use to me if I should ever come in pursuit of his body do all you can I beg of you and you will not lose anything by it and I wish you would tell me your Capt. name when you write to me for I would like to know Mrs Usher's friend will write to her and tell her to find you if you cannot find her and when you see her please tell her all you know and she will tell me all the particulars when she comes home if I dont see you before that time Mrs Mayhew is at the same agency and if you see her before you do Miss Usher she will tell you where to find her I will now Close leaveing the whole matter to you hopeing that you will do all you can for me and my poor mother who feels so sad and sorrowful at the fate of her dear Son
