To Have and to Hold, the aforegranted and bargained premises, with all the
privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said Moses Jewett 2d to
his heirs and assigns, to ~~his~~ their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant
with the said ~~Moses Jewett~~ *Moses Jewett* his heirs
and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all
incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said ~~Moses~~
Jewett 2d to hold as aforesaid. And that I will warrant and defend the same to the
said ~~Moses Jewett 2d~~ *Moses Jewett 2d*

his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all
persons.
