

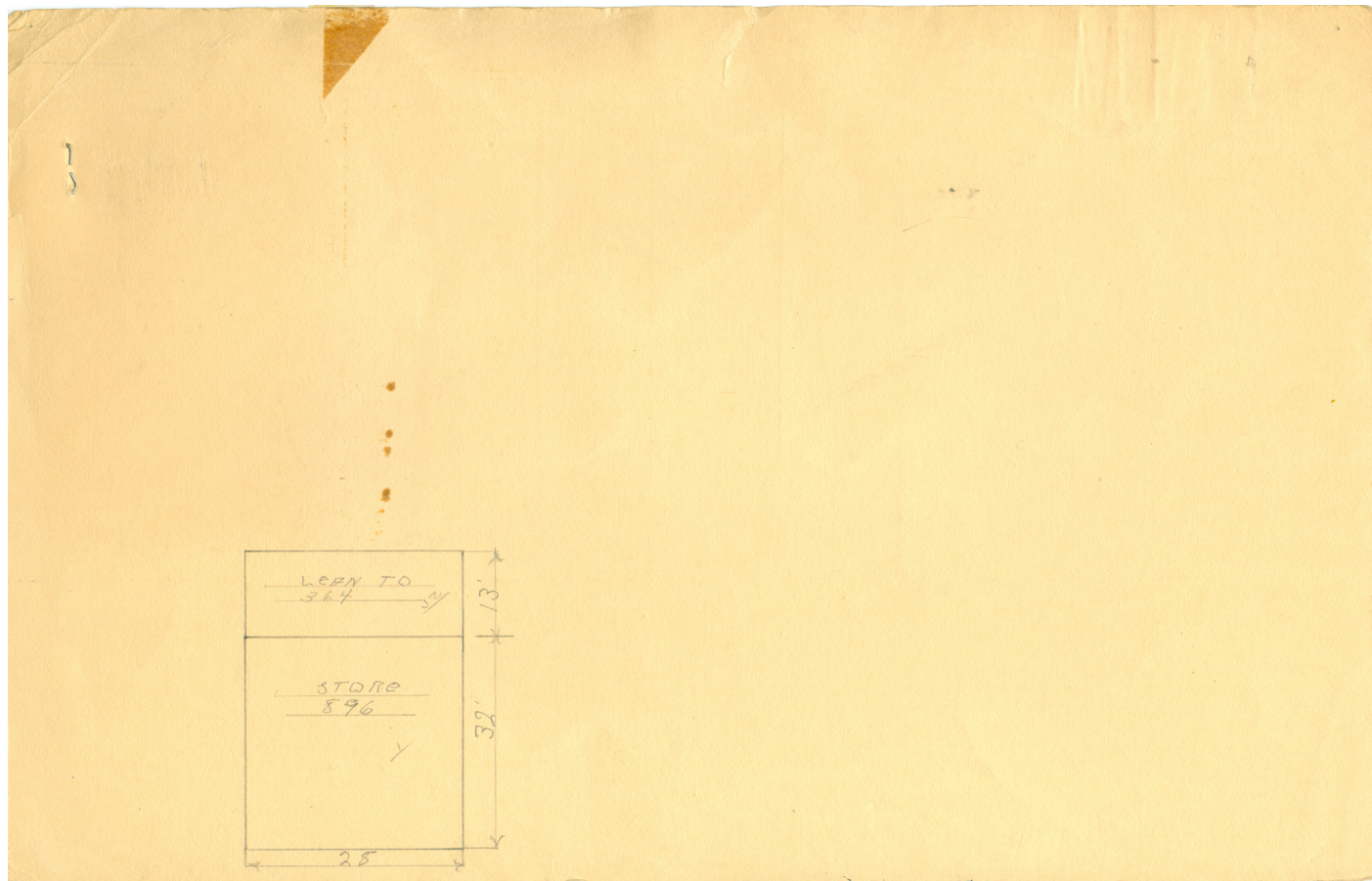

(Jesse Murphy's Store) (owned by Wales & Hamblen Co.) Not recorded (Previous deed recorded as above. Part of lot (7) in Range (14). bounded and described as follows:- Commencing on the Northerly side of Main St. in Bridgton Center Village on said Bridgtons at the south-westerly corner thereon of the store building lot of said Wales & Hamblen (owned by the heirs of Joseph T. Wales and the trustees of Cumberland Lodge, #30 I.O.O.F.; thence Northerly by said Store building Lots Westerly line to the Northerly range line of said 14th Range; thence Westerly on said range line to an iron pipe driven into the ground as the Northwesterly corner of the premises hereby conveyed; thence south about (22) degrees and (15') West running parallel with and one foot from the Easterly side of the "Confectionary Shop" building formerly owned by Edward M. Barry now owned by said Main Street a distance of about (30) feet to the point of commencement.
