


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY
Store lot of Chas. Gleason.

"Ommence at the store lot originally conveyed by Sophia Gibbs to one Lewis Smith and now owned and occupied by Bridgton Furniture Company, and which said corner is a point on the southerly side of Main St. and is (7%) feet easterly of the big elm stump on the easterly side of said Smith-lot; thence from said corner run South (24) degrees East (course registered Aug. 20, 1887) and by said Smith's Easterly side line, to Steven's Brook; thence Easterly (38) feet, when measured at right angles to the first course run; thence North 24 degrees East (on Aug. 20, 1887) and parallel with and (38) feet from the aforesaid easterly side-line of said Smith-lot, to said Main St; thence Westerly by said Main St. (38) feet to the point and corner thereon begun at.

Also a small triangular shaped parcel of land lying on the southerly side of said Main St. and next easterly of the first above described lot:- Commence on the southerly side of said street and at the northeasterly corner, thereon, of said first above described lot,
