Launched in 2001, Maine Memory Network is a statewide digital museum developed and managed by Maine Historical Society. It provides access to more than 20,000 historical items—photographs, letters, journals, objects—contributed by 250+ organizations across Maine. Maine Memory also includes hundreds of online exhibits, a comprehensive introduction to Maine history, resources for teachers, tools that enable visitors to save, organize, and share items, and much more.

- **Searching the Digital Archive:** Provides multiple ways to find items in Maine Memory including browsing subjects, keyword searches, advanced searches, and searching by contributor or town.
